The wind turbine blades are the elongated objects protruding from the center of the motor. They are anywhere from 50 meters to 120 meters (164 ft. to 393.7 ft.).

Wind turbine blades are truly massive, with lengths reaching up to 107 meters--about the size of a football field. For typical 1.5 MW turbines, blade lengths range from 32.5 to 40 meters. Larger blades ...

For large-sized turbines, the size of blades on a wind turbine is 280 feet, enabling the generation of several megawatts of power. On average, wind turbine blades are 116 feet in length, but they are still ...

The size of a wind turbine blade varies dramatically, but on average, modern land-based wind turbine blades range from 115 to 260 feet (35 to 80 meters) in length, while offshore wind turbine blades can ...

In 2023, the average rotor diameter of newly-installed wind turbines was over 133.8 meters (~438 feet)--longer than a football field, or about as tall as the Great Pyramid of Giza. Larger rotor diameters allow ...
