Solar panels should not be flat because they can collect water, which will build up on the surface and damage the solar cells. So, it is much better to angle them; not too much - as little as three to four ...

While installing photovoltaic (PV) shingles requires a minimum slope of 2:12, solar panels can indeed be installed flat on such a roof--as long as a slight angle still exists between it and the PV panels.

Flat roofs have a minimal slope allowance that will accommodate solar PV panel systems. A roof having a rise of 0.25 inches over a 12-inch run -- known as a 0.25:12 pitch roof -- is ...
